

Visit to CG-Vidhan Sabha

Faculty of Management and Faculty of Commerce of ICAI University Raipur organized a visit to Vidhan Sabha, the legislative assembly of the state of Chhattisgarh, on 7th February 2024 for MBA , BBA, and B.Com students as a part of an educational trip, a total of 125 students and 10 faculties were present on the visit. The purpose of the visit was to understand the structure, functioning, and significance of the Chhattisgarh Vidhan Sabha in the state's governance system. The aim was to familiarize our students with the legislative procedures, debates, and decision-making processes that shape state policies and laws. Upon arrival at the Chhattisgarh Vidhan Sabha, assembly staff provided us with visitor badges and guided us through the security procedures. We were then escorted to the visitors' gallery inside the assembly hall, where students had a clear view of the proceedings. The students also visited various chambers of the Vidhan Sabha and, they also saw the central hall and a senior official of Vidhan Sabha describe the working of Vidhan Sabha and answered the queries of students. At last, students visited Vidhan Sabha Library, it has a collection of over 20,000 books and reports and it subscribes 11 magazines, 91 journals, and 18 newspapers.

Students gained insights into the roles and responsibilities of elected representatives, the dynamics of legislative debates, and the importance of public participation in governance.
